WESTCHESTER PHILHARMONIC CELEBRATES INDEPENDENCE DAY WITH FREE CONCERT

Annual Music Fest at Kensico Dam to Draw More Than 10,000

(White Plains, New York) - On Tuesday, July 3 the Westchester Philharmonic will play its annual Independence Day concert at Kensico Dam Plaza in Valhalla as part of Music Fest, hosted by the Westchester County Parks Department. Music Fest will begin at 6:30 pm with The Cal Payne Project and the Westchester Philharmonic's program of American music and patriotic favorites will begin at 8 pm. This performance is FREE of charge.

Paul Lustig Dunkel, Music Director and Conductor of the Westchester Philharmonic, will lead the orchestra in great American favorites such as Aaron Copland's Hoedown, Fantasy by Duke Ellington and Bernard Herrmann, a West Side Story medley by Leonard Bernstein, and much more. The concert will conclude with Sousa's the Stars and Stripes Forever followed by a fireworks display. This marks the fourth consecutive year the orchestra has performed in celebration of Independence Day at Kensico Dam Plaza,

each attracting audiences of over 10,000 adults and children.

Performance Information

The park opens at 5 pm for picnicking. Concerts begin at 6:30 pm with The Cal Payne Project and the Westchester Philharmonic takes the stage at 8 pm. A fireworks display will follow the concert. This is a free event. Carpooling is suggested. Concert-goers should bring lawn chairs or blankets for seating. For more information call (914) 864-PARK.
